July 12, 2023 @ 6:00 PM – Poweshiek County Fairgrounds, north property. Use NE fairgrounds driveway, contestant parking will be marked. Weigh-ins starting at 3:00PM @ New Century FS – 1017 Ogan Ave.

Pre-entry \$15 per hook or \$20 per hook day of -50% payback (65%/35%) to top 2 pullers of each class. Pre-entry forms are available at poweshiekcountyfair.org or at the Poweshiek County Fair office.

- Competitors must be 21 years of age or older.
- 2wd tractors, up to 10,500#
- Weight classes starting at 3,500# up to 10,500# in 500# increments.
- Farm tractors of any year are able to enter.
- Each tractor may enter in up to 3 weight classes with 1 hook per class.
- Tractors will pull in the order they are registered.
- The tractor and sled must stay in bounds or be disqualified.
- Drivers will be red flagged if the front end raises higher than approximately 18".
- Tractors must stop immediately upon the red flag signal from the flagman or be disqualified. If the track judge stops the puller for any reason the puller takes the distance where they were stopped. If stopped within the first 50 feet, puller is entitled to 1 restart.
- The first puller of each class can re-pull if desired. They must re-pull no later than the 3rd position and take the 2nd distance.
- You may only protest tractors in your class; your tractor will also be inspected. The protest must be made before the beginning of the next class. Anyone not allowing inspection will be disqualified.
- All judges, flagman, and/or officials decisions are final
- 4 MPH speed limit
- Must have original type of drawbar, with washers of clevis not to exceed 18"high or be less than 18" from the center of the rear axle to the hitch point. 2-point hitches must be in a fixed position. Pulling from a 3-point hitch is not allowed.
- Clevis must be stationary and/or be mechanically fastened.
- NO DUALS OR CUT TIRES.
- 5,500# or less 15.5 x 38" or 16.9 x 34" max tire size
 6,000# 9,000# 18.4 x 38" max tire size
 9,500# and up unlimited tire size
- Stationary, original type seat must be used.
- Driver must remain firmly seated in a forward or normal upright position at all times. No bouncing or excessive movement permitted.
- Fenders are required if tractor was originally equipped. No essential equipment can be removed.
- All weights must be stationary and mechanically fastened to the tractor.
- No fuel mixtures allowed.
- Tractor must have stock engine and pump, 5% over factory RPM's are allowed
