



Clover Kids Livestock Entry Form Submission


Step 3: Provide an email where you can be contacted if there are questions, grade the Clover Kid has completed (will have completed by fair), and the club they participate in.





Step 13: If your Clover Kid is bringing a bottle calf, select Yes. If they are not bringing a bottle calf, leave it on No and hit next to move on. Bulk bedding will be provided and the fee will be charged at the end of this entry.

Step 14: Provide the calf's name, entire tag number and birthdate.

If the calf is a heifer and your child will be in 4-H next year or another 4-H'er might bring the heifer to fair next year as a 2nd Year Breeding Heifer or Breeding Heifer, it **MUST** have a tattoo in order to be shown. Unless it already has a tattoo at fair this year, it is recommended to have them tattooed on Sunday @ 9am.

Step 16: If you entered a bottle calf, this is the next screen you will see.

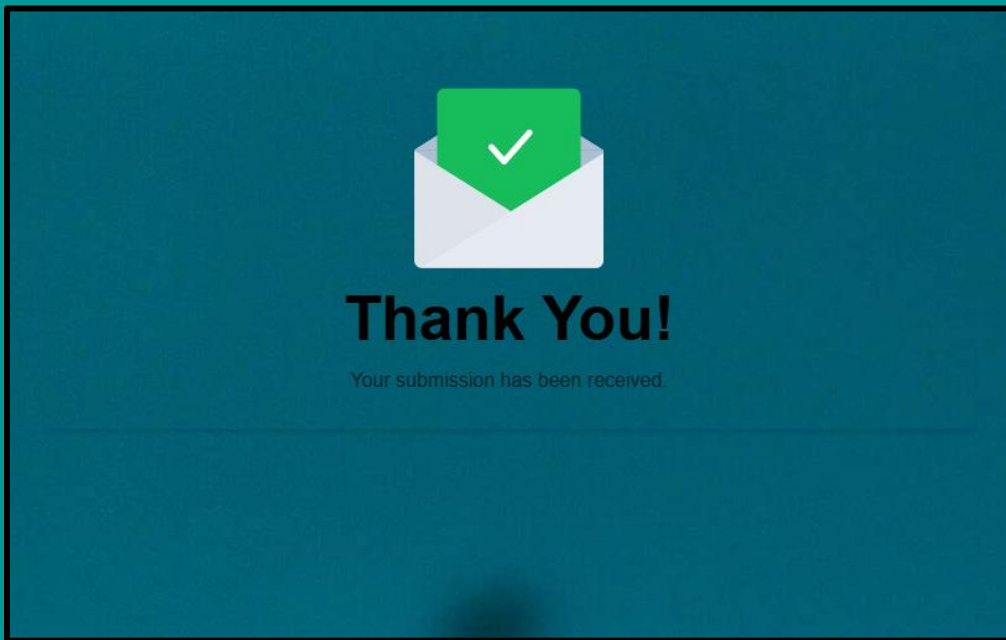

FAQS:

- All inputs with a red * require information before you can move forward.
- If you get a red error message, a response was skipped and must be completed before moving to the next page.
- If you enter a bottle calf, you must pay for the bedding with your entry or it will not allow you to submit, the bedding fee isn't optional.
- For all species except bottle calves, you must provide your own bedding (straw isn't allowed)
- Paper entries are not accepted
- You will receive a confirmation email with a pdf attachment of your entire entry – retain this email.
- Your stall/pen assignments will be completed by the species superintendent just prior to fair, they are not to be changed by anyone other than the superintendent.
- It is recommended to complete the entries prior to 6/30 as entries will not be accepted after 11:59pm on that date for any reason, including internet issues, form issues, submission issues, etc.
- There is not a late fee charge for Clover Kid entries received after 6/15 – there is a \$50 late fee per animal for all 4-H entries submitted after 11:59pm on 6/15.
